Each Academy has a selective application process that involves teacher recommendations and course and grade pre-requisites that are spelled out for each Academy.

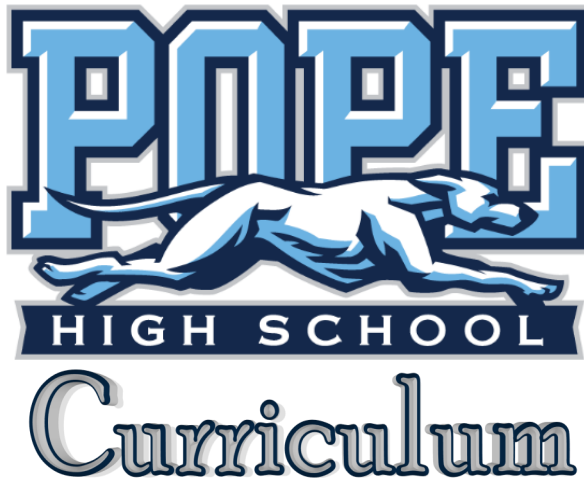
Students graduating from an Academy will have a descriptive profile describing the program in detail attached to their transcript.
